## TOWN OF CLINTON REGULAR BOARD MEETING

August 19, 2025

The regular meeting of the Town of Clinton was called to order by Chairman Robert Butler at 6:00 PM with Supervisors Peter Ramfjord, Jake Shavor, Clerk Brian Mayry and Fire Chief Jim Theodore. Treasurer Elaine Santi was absent. All in attendance recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes of the last regular meeting were distributed by the Clerk. Chairman Ramfjord motioned to wave reading the minutes and accept the minutes as distributed, second by Supervisor Shavor. Motion carried unanimously.

The Treasurer's Report was provided in advance by Treasurer Santi. Chairman Robert Butler motioned to accept the financial report, second by Supervisor Shavor and unanimously carried.

Chairman Butler motioned to pay the submitted bills and claim forms. The motion was second by Supervisor Ramfjord and prevailed unanimously.

Supervisor Ramfjord stated that the roads are in good seasonal condition. The power line to the skating rink well will be dug in. Bids are being accepted for the skating rink boards replacement.

Chairman Butler motioned to pay the CTC invoice for \$400,000.00 which was the grant from St. Louis County for the broadband project.

Fire Chief Theodore gave an overview of the latest runs and an overview of the department's current business. The department responded to five fire department alarms and five EMS runs. Funds for the DNR grant with a 50/50 match is still being waited on. Charles Mesia made application for membership to the Fire Department. Supervisor Ramfjord motioned to accept Mr. Mesia's membership application. The motion was second by Chairman Butler and prevailed unanimously. The updated / amended relief associatgion bylaws were presented for approval. Supervisor Ramfjord motioned to accept the presented bylaws. The motion was second by Chairman Butler and prevailed unanimously.

Supervisor Ramfjord motioned that the meeting be adjourned until the next regular meeting on September 16 , 2025 beginning at 6:00 PM. Chairman Butler second and the meeting adjourned at 6:42 PM.
